REQUIREMENTS OF DAVID HUBBELL CONCERTO COMPETITION

Eligibility:

- A. The competition is open to any music student who (1) is a member of the ACYO or (2) studies with a music teacher in Alachua County or (3) resides in Alachua County.
- B. The applicant has not previously won the competition.
- C. The composition to be performed is approved by the ACYO Conductor.

Application Procedure:

Due: Applications are to be post marked by December 15, using the form provided.

Fee: \$15.00 refundable if not accepted

Notification: All applicants will be notified by January 15 about acceptance and date and time of the audition.

The Audition:

Date: Sunday February 7th, 2010 at 1 PM in Room 120 University of Florida Music Building.

Applicant will perform from memory one movement of a concerto or up to two arias or songs.

Performance time will not be limited, but give accurate duration on form.

Applicant will provide his/her own accompanist

Applicant will provide the judges with one original copy of the music performed.

Applicants will be given their adjudication forms after the audition.

Winner:

The judges may declare a winner based on points received from the panel of judges. Judges need not declare a winner. The ACYO Conductor will be available to the judges for consultation, if necessary, about their decision.

The winner will be announced at the conclusion of the auditions.

The winner will perform the audition piece with the ACYO during its Spring Concert scheduled for Sunday April 25, 2010 at 7:00 PM in Memorial Auditorium at the University of Florida.
